**Work with a partner**; *translate* these sentences to Spanish using preterite:

1. Yesterday I **sang** my favorite song. (**cantar**)
2. My friend **spoke** Spanish to me *an hour ago*. (**hablar**)  
NOTE: To say “ago”, use the phrase “**hace** \_\_\_\_\_”, where the time period goes in the blank
3. Last week you (*tú*) **danced** at the party. (**bailar**)
4. We **studied** the preterite yesterday. (**estudiar**)
5. Many people **watched** Sr. Garnet’s video on YouTube. (**mirar**)
6. On Saturday, I **slept** until 11am. (**dormir** – *no stem change in preterite yo*)
7. Did you **write** your name on your paper? (**escribir**)
8. Who **ate** my lunch?!? (**comer**) NOTE: *quién* is treated as masculine singular, like *él*
9. We **lived** in tents when we camped in the mountains. (**vivir**)
10. The boys **ran** for an hour, then they **drank** a lot of water. (**correr**, **beber**)
