**Translate these sentences to Spanish.** Use preterite endings, see the chart on the board, especially for the –ER/-IR verbs.

1. I **visited** the taco store. (**visitar**)

(Vocab hint: What's the suffix that means "store"? Zapatos -> zapatería)

2. I **asked** the man "How much do tacos cost?". (**preguntar**)

3. He **spoke** in Spanish: "Tuesday is taco day, fifty cents". (**hablar**)

4. I **looked** in my pocket. (**mirar**) (Vocab hint: the word for "bag" + -illo)

5. I **bought** twenty-seven tacos. (**comprar**)

6. I **ate** twelve tacos. (**comer**)

7. I **ran** to the bathroom. (**correr**)

8. I **thought** "I ate a lot.... *Too much!*" (**pensar**) (Vocab: demasiado)

9. I **threw up**. (**vomitar**)

10. I **decided** to not eat the other tacos. (**decidir**)
