1. When you go to the airport, you need to bring your ID and passport.
2. What time is it? When is your flight? 2:45pm? It's coming soon!
3. I have your suitcase. It's big! How much clothing do you have?
4. I want to ask the flight attendant a question. Where is she?

For the next section, use the **preterite** of the verb indicated:

5. Did you **speak** to the flight attendant? (**hablar**)
6. They **wrote** my name on the ticket, but it's not correct. (**escribir**)
7. Okay, the pilot **entered** the plane. We have 5 minutes. (**entrar**)
8. The airline **lost** my luggage! (**perder**, no stem change in preterite)
