



## Práctica: Preterite irregular

**Translate VERBS ONLY to Spanish preterite. FYI nearly all are irregular.**

- 1) It **was** last month, late at night; a friend **came** to my house. (**ser; venir**)
- 2) He **wanted** to do something, he **couldn't** sleep. (**querer, poder**)
- 3) He **brought** a horror movie and videogames. (**traer**)
- 4) He **wanted** to watch the movie, but I didn't **want** to watch it. (**querer x2**)
- 5) I **said** "I don't like scary movies" and he said "Okay." (**decir, decir**)
- 6) We **put** the videogame disc in the Xbox. (**poner**)
- 7) I **looked** at the television. The game **was** in Japanese. (**mirar, estar**)
- 8) My friend **translated** the menu, and **changed** it. (**traducir, cambiar**)
- 9) Meanwhile (*mientras tanto*), I **walked** to the kitchen (**andar**)...
- 10) ...and **made** a sandwich, because I **was hungry**. (**hacer, tener hambre**)
- 11) When I **returned**, my friend **wasn't** in the room (**volver, estar**)
- 12) I **knew** it was a prank, but it **gave** me *the chills*. (**saber, dar escalofrios**)
- 13) He didn't **fit** under the bed... then I **realized**... (**caber, saber**)
- 14) He **was** in the closet! I **searched** for him ... (**estar, buscar**)
- 15) ..and he **made** a loud shout. He **wanted** to scare me. (**hacer, querer**)
- 16) ...but I **had** the advantage: I **knew** where he was, and I **had** a monster mask and a water gun. (**tener, saber, tener**)
