- 6:45am Head count & prepare to get on bus
- 6:55am Bus departs from Peninsula High School, heading for USC
  - → 7:00 − 8:45 Travel time to USC Google Traffic suggests travel time of about 50 min to 1 hour 40 min, 24.6 miles via 110 North

From the I-110/Harbor Freeway (northbound):

- Exit the freeway at Exposition Boulevard.
- At the bottom of the off-ramp, go straight through the signal and keep to the left.
- Follow the road under the freeway. Remain on Exposition and continue to Vermont Avenue
- Turn right at Vermont Avenue, and continue to 36th Place.
- Turn right at 36th Place, and enter campus through Entrance 6



Tell the parking attendant/kiosk at Entrance 6 that you are dropping off students at Downey Way and Watt Way (Vivian Hall; 5-C on the map).

Proceed down Downey Way and make a right onto Watt Way. Please unload your students on the southwest corner of the intersection in front of Vivian Hall (5-C on the map).

After the bus is unloaded, the bus driver should head south down Watt Way, exit through Entrance 1 and proceed to the bus parking at Exposition Park. Cost is \$30 and \$12 for yellow school buses (cash only). Exposition Park can be reached at (213) 744-7458.

Students and other guests should walk east on Downey Way and make a left/north on Trousdale Parkway. There is an entrance to the Tutor Campus Center (TCC, Sample Hall) on Trousdale if you have a presentation before your tour. If your visit begins with a tour, continue north on Trousdale until you reach Tommy Trojan on your left.
