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## Direct object pronouns

- Study the following sentences, paying attention to the boldfaced words. Then, review the chart below that contains the direct object pronouns in Spanish.

Voy a limpiar **la cocina**. → Voy a limpiar**la**.  
(I am going to clean **the kitchen**.) OR (I am going to clean **it**.)  
La voy a limpiar.

Direct object pronouns	
Singular	Plural
me (me)	nos (us)
te (you) (familiar)	os (you) (familiar)
lo (you/him/it) (formal)	los (you formal/them masculine)
la (you/her/it) (formal)	las (you formal/them feminine)

**Negative commands with object pronouns:** With a negative command, the object pronoun(s) will precede the verb in its imperative form. The object pronoun will be independent of the verb. When there are two object pronouns, the RID rule will apply.

<i>¡No me mires!</i>	Don't look at me!	<i>¡No lo hagas!</i>	Don't do it!
<i>¡No le des el dinero!</i>	Don't give him the money!	<i>¡No se lo digas!</i>	Don't tell it to him!
<i>¡No lo pongas allí!</i>	Don't put it there!	<i>¡No los compres!</i>	Don't buy them!
