1) The book pleases **me**.

**To me**, the book is pleasing → **gustar**

2) Does the movie annoy **you**?

**To you**, is the movie annoying? → **molestar**

3) **To her**, science is fascinating.

Science fascinates **her**. → **fascinar**

4) **To him**, sports are interesting.

Sports interest **him**. → **interesar**

5) Spanish frustrates **us** sometimes.

**To us**, Spanish is frustrating sometimes. → **frustrar**

6) The music irritates **them**.

**To them**, the music is irritating. → **irritar**
