**Translate these sentences to Spanish.** Use preterite endings, see the chart on the board, especially for the –ER/-IR verbs.

1.1 <u>visited</u> the taco store. (visitar)

(Vocab hint: What's the suffix that means "store"? Zapatos -> zapatería)

- 2.I <u>asked</u> the man "How much do tacos cost?". (preguntar)
- 3.He **spoke** in Spanish: "Tuesday is taco day, fifty cents". (**hablar**)
- 4.1 looked in my pocket. (mirar) (Vocab hint: the word for "bag" + -illo)
- 5.1 **bought** twenty-seven tacos. (**comprar**)
- 6.1 <u>ate</u> twelve tacos. (comer)
- 7.1 <u>ran</u> to the bathroom. (correr)
- 8.I thought "I ate a lot.... Too much!" (pensar) (Vocab: demasiado)
- 9.1 threw up. (vomitar)
- 10.1 decided to not eat the other tacos. (decidir)
