

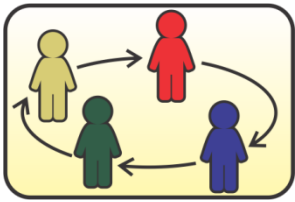
Práctica *Spanish 2 & Spanish 2 MCR*

3. *What do you like to do?* > I like to swim.
4. *Where do you live?* > I live in Rolling Hills Estates, California.
5. *Where are you from?* > I'm from Mexico City, Mexico.
6. *Who is he?* > This is my friend, Roberto. (Hint: "I present to you...")
7. *Maria, your brother Roberto is cute!* > He's my boyfriend!!
8. *I'm sorry.* > It's okay (Hint: "It's fine/good.")

4. *Tener* and *ir* are “irregular”, what does that mean? Compare to regular verbs, and use examples of both *tener* and *ir*. Don't forget common expressions using *tener*, and *ir + a*.
