4. My mom **opened** the door and **left** (\*from) the house. (**salir de**)
5. I **needed** to go to the bathroom.
6. I **decided** it **was worth it** ... (to be worth it = **valer** la pena)
7. My mom **got angry**.
8. I **arrived** late to school.
9. My teacher **spoke** to me about arriving late, and I **listened**.
