

Translate to Spanish, using Direct Object Pronouns and Indirect Object Pronouns

- 1. "The homework, do you have <u>it?</u>" "No, I'm looking for <u>it."</u>
- 2. "I like tacos. I want to buy them."
- 3. "She gives **you** gifts (*regalos*)."
- 4. "They sent <u>us</u> a present." (Mandar = to send)
- 5. "I wrote (*to you*) a letter. Did you receive *it*?"
- 6. "Kids in Africa need money. I want to help them. I will send it."
- 7. "That **book** can you pass **it** to me?" (use "pasar")
