Translate to Spanish, preterite. Some verbs are regular, most are irregular.

- 1) It **was** Winter Vacation, late at night; My friend **called**. (ser; llamar)
- 2) He **wanted** to do something, he **couldn't** sleep. (querer, poder)
- 3) We **decided** to spend time at my house. (decidir)
- 4) I **played** video games and I **waited**. (jugar, esperar)
- 5) He didn't **arrive** quickly, and I **started** to fall asleep. (llegar, empezar)
- 6) Then I **heard** a sound, and I didn't **know** what it **was**. (oír, saber, ser)
- 7) I **looked** at the clock. It **said** midnight. (mirar, decir)
- 8) I **went** to the door, and **opened** it. (ir, abrir)
- 9) No one **was** outside... (estar)
- 10) Then, my friend **yelled** "Surprise!" and he **appeared**. (gritar, aparecer)
- 11) "You **thought** I was a monster, right?" he **asked**. (pensar, preguntar)
- 12) "No, you didn't **give** me time to think" I **explained**. (dar, explicar)
- 13) "Did you **bring** food?" (traer)
- 14) We **ate** and we **talked** until morning. (comer, hablar)
