

Práctica: Preterite regular & irregular Spanish 2 MCR martes, el 12 de enero, 2016

Translate to Spanish, preterite. Some verbs are regular, most are irregular.

- 1) It <u>was</u> Winter Vacation, late at night; My friend <u>called</u>. (ser; llamar)
- 2) He <u>wanted</u> to do something, he <u>couldn't</u> sleep. (querer, poder)
- 3) We **<u>decided</u>** to spend time at my house. (**decidir**)
- 4) I played video games and I waited. (jugar, esperar)
- 5) He didn't arrive quickly, and I started to fall asleep. (Ilegar, empezar)
- 6) Then I heard a sound, and I didn't know what it was. (oir, saber, ser)
- 7) I looked at the clock. It said midnight. (mirar, decir)
- 8) I went to the door, and opened it. (ir, abrir)
- 9) No one <u>was</u> outside... (estar)
- 10) Then, my friend yelled "Surprise!" and he appeared. (gritar, aparecer)
- 11) "You thought I was a monster, right?" he asked. (pensar, preguntar)
- 12) "No, you didn't give me time to think" I explained. (dar, explicar)
- 13) "Did you bring food?" (traer)
- 14) We ate and we talked until morning. (comer, hablar)
